



JOINT PROVIDERS

Dannemiller's mission is to ensure that all direct and joint provided CME educational activities are in full compliance with Joint Accreditation (JA) criteria, guidelines, and Standards for Integrity and Independence in Accredited Continuing Education.

Dannemiller is charged with identification, mitigation, and disclosure of all financial relationships with ineligible companies, activity planning committees, and activity faculty (anyone in a position to control the content of an educational activity) to produce balanced, and scientifically based accredited products that are free of commercial bias of ineligible companies (as defined by JA).

What is Dannemiller responsible for during the process of Joint Providership?

- 1** Responding promptly with the approval, we are able to accredit your event (usually within one week of receiving your Joint Provider Application).
- 2** Working with you throughout the entire process to communicate requirements, provide training and resources, provide examples/templates, when possible, answer questions, etc.
- 3** Providing necessary oversight throughout the process to ensure CME activities meet AMA expectations and the Joint Accreditation (JA) joint provider criteria and requirements, including compliance with all JA Standards for Integrity and Independence in Accredited Continuing Education.
- 4** Activity evaluation and certificate management in Dannemiller's Learning Management System (LMS).
- 5** Retaining evaluation outcomes and learner certificates for requests within the six-year required period.
- 6** On-going technical support to any learner that is completing an evaluation or claiming a certificate with verified attendance.
